General Information; McCall Lake Cruises' vessel "The Idaho" with capacity up to 85 passengers, full bar, and on board restrooms are available for charter. The heated enclosed interior area will accommodate up to 40 passengers for set down dining, up to 50 passengers for standing appetizer & cocktail events. The upper deck is limited to 55 passengers at any one time. We offer standard complement of interior/exterior tables & chairs are available for use during the cruise. McCall Lake Cruises Dock is located lake side behind the Yacht Club Building at 203 E. Lake. Should you wish to be picked up at another Dock location on Payette Lake please let us know. We do require a minimum of 5 feet of water depth for the back of the boat when docking. The person requesting pickup at another dock is responsible for obtaining permission from the dock owner and any damage that may occur. There may be a small Vessel ferry charge when traveling from our dock to the requested dock for pickup and/or drop off, depending on the location. **Children must be under a responsible adult supervision at all times while on board!** Sorry we **do not allow any outside beverages** to be brought on board.

Deposit, Payment & Cancellations; **To secure the date of your event, a deposit of \$300.00 is required along with this signed contract.** The deposit will go towards your final bill. Events may be cancelled and funds may be refunded up to 60 days prior to the scheduled charter date. Thereafter, THE DEPOSIT IS NOT REFUNDABLE. The full payment of the charter fee, plus any additional items is due prior disembarking after the cruise. McCall Lake Cruises cannot and will not be responsible for acts of God, inclement weather, cancellations or the parties' change of plans. McCall Lake Cruises reserves the rights to cancel the cruise event do to safety concerns of any type, with full refund of your deposit.

Liquor, Wine & Beer; All alcohol must be purchased through McCall Lake Cruises and will be served by onboard crew members. Absolutely no outside alcohol may be brought on board; if any is found, it will be confiscated & discarded of immediately. The captain & any crew member of the vessel has the authority at any time to discontinue, close or refuse bar sales to any individual or group to maintain the safety of the passengers, crew, and/or vessel. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted to be taken off of the boat at any time. Should you wish to have onboard a specific brand or type of beverage, please let us know at least 2 weeks prior to your cruise? We will do our best to accommodate your wish.

Set up & Decorating; A complimentary 30 minute period is generally available prior to the contracted time for guest pre-boarding and/or decoration. Speak with McCall Lake Cruises staff about additional event prep time needs. Decorating is the responsibility of the charterer. No decorations are allowed that leave any kind of residue, flames or damage; this includes confetti, glitter, silly string, tacks, staples, and all types of tape or other items inside or outside the vessel. Any and all decorations may be subject to approval by MLC staff for the purpose of maintaining the condition and safety of the vessel. Simply put, please keep our vessel easily cleanable, and pristine. Following the cruise all decorations will be required to be removed in a timely safe manner.

Catering & Foods; Because of additional wear and tear on the vessel as well as clean-up labor, all catering and foods for charter cruises must be approved by McCall Lake Cruises and are subject to \$100.00 additional charge when catered by one of our approved caterers. Self Catering will be subject to a \$200.00 additional charge, with \$100 refunded upon cleaning up after yourselves & leaving our entire boat CLEAN! Caterers must contact McCall Lake Cruises at least two weeks prior to the event to discuss various requirements on board The Idaho. It is strongly suggested they visit "The Idaho" prior to the charter cruise as well. In general, no open flame, absolutely no propane gas, or intense heat sources may be used on the vessel. Chafing dishes with gel flame canisters are permitted in certain areas. Crock Pots, Electric Cooking plates are welcome, please advise the captain prior to plugging into our on board power system.

Music and Entertainment; All musicians and/or DJs must cease playing upon returning to the dock or when instructed to do so by the captain of the vessel. Volume levels may also be adjusted by the captain of the vessel to prevent the disturbance of the lakeside residents. Bubble machines, fog machines, or any other compound or substance spread on the floor is not allowed.

Additional Information

- **McCall Lake Cruises is a smoke-free facility. There is no smoking of any sort allowed on the dock or on board The Idaho.**
- No sparklers, bottle rockets, fire crackers or any other fireworks are allowed. No exceptions.
- Absolutely no weapons or firearms are allowed on McCall Lake Cruises property or vessel.
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on board or on the dock.
- No pets are allowed aboard the vessel at any time, except for service animals.
- Fishing, and throwing any material or substance overboard are all strictly prohibited.
- Handicap assistance for boarding is available on request.

General Liability Agreement

BY LAW, NO ONE UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE MAY CONSUME OR TASTE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. The management may ask guests for Identification to verify age. McCall Lake Cruises reserves the right to ask the entire party to leave if a minor is consuming alcohol or

an adult is providing alcohol to a minor. The party renting the vessel shall ensure no underage drinking is allowed. McCall Lake Cruises is unable to assume responsibility for damage or loss of any merchandise or articles left on premise before, during or after your event. McCall Lake Cruises personnel have the authority to contact law enforcement officials, if necessary, to protect property and personnel. McCall Lake Cruises will not be held liable for injuries or property damage/loss during this function, including, but not limited to: death, personal injury, property damage and any other incidents that may occur to any person(s) by use of the vessel and premises during the term of this agreement. The term of this agreement begins when the first guest arrives on the property and concludes when final payment has been made, and the last person leaves the property.

Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement; McCall Lake Cruises shall not be liable for any claim, loss, injury, damage or expense, either with respect to person or property, sustained by you, or by any of your employees, agents, invitees and guests due to your use of the facilities, or arising out of the use, operation or condition of any equipment, machines or appliances used in the facilities, or arising from any acts of negligence or the negligence of any employees, agents, invitees or guests of yours. It is agreed and understood that you hereby expressly release and discharge McCall Lake Cruises and its owners, officers, employees and agents from any and all demands, claims and actions arising out of any such causes. Moreover, it is agreed and understood that you shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless McCall Lake Cruises and its officers, directors, employees and agents from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, losses, costs, damages and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees) or any cause or action occasioned by or arising out of any accident or other occurrence whatsoever causing or inflicting injury and/or damage to any person or property and/ or occurring in, upon or about the facilities due directly or indirectly to your use of the facilities. Should there be any sort of litigation you hereby agree that any & all litigation will take place in Valley County, Idaho. You agree to a maximum limit of \$10,000.00. Notice must be given within 6 months from date of cruise. This obligation of yours to protect, indemnify and hold harmless McCall Lake Cruises shall include the obligation to pay all reasonable expenses incurred by McCall Lake Cruises in defending any of such claims, including all attorney costs. This event involves risk. Signer of this contract is responsible for all guests & is responsible for communication with all guests.

Authorities; McCall Lake Cruises reserves the authority to change the conditions of, or cancel, this agreement up to 60 days prior to charter should unforeseen or extreme circumstances arise. All deposits and payments will be returned in the event McCall Lake Cruises cancels the event. At any point during the cruise, to maintain and protect the safety of the passenger, crew, and vessel, the captain of the vessel has the authority to 1) discontinue the cruise due to unlawful, unsafe, or inappropriate behavior aboard the vessel, and/or 2) discontinue, close or refuse service to any individual or group.

I, _____ (Charterer's name) have read and **agree to all terms in this contract** for the charter of the boat (The IDAHO). We kindly ask for an approximate final number of passengers within three (3) days prior to the cruise so McCall Lake Cruises can plan for adequate staffing. This agreement must be signed and returned to McCall Lake Cruises along with a deposit of \$300.00 to confirm your reservation. Final payment is due and payable in full at conclusion of the cruise prior to disembarking.
